The Uniform Patrol Division is repsonsible for most of the Calls for Service dispatched by the E-911 Center. JPD took 4249 calls for service during April 2020, down from 5108 in March 2020. As a whole, JPD filed 705 incident reports in April 2020, bringing the total for the year to 3627. A total of 138 Warrants were served by JPD during April 2020 across several divisions including Uniform Patrol, Street Crimes, Warrants, CID, DTF, and more.


